EU-CORD Ukraine Response

Brussels, Belgium, February 25, 2022

In light of events in Ukraine, EU-CORD members are mobilising to respond to the emerging humanitarian crisis in a very uncertain and fluid situation.

Hungarian Baptist Aid is already distributing humanitarian aid to people in Brehove, Zakarpathia and their Rescue 24 team; an international special rescue team is on standby. Dutch agency Dorcas is planning to respond in Ukraine and Moldova as well as considering a response in Romania. Medair (Switzerland) is sending a team to the region to assess their response.

EU-CORD members LM International, Mission East and Fida have launched private fundraising campaigns to support local and international partners who are already operational.

Other members assessing their responses are Sign of Hope, PMU and Medair.

Our prayers are with all those caught up in this conflict and we hope for a peaceful resolution.
